CALL 211 FOR COMPREHENSIVE INFORMATION ON AVAILABLE COMMUNITY SERVICES

To apply for assistance, applicants may be required to provide one or more of the following proofs of identification. It is recommended that applicants contact the agency prior to arrival to ensure they present the appropriate documentation upon arrival in order to be assisted.

ID for each person in the household:

- ◆ Drivers license or other DMV issued ID, Social Security card, birth certificate, passport.
- ◆ Current alien resident card or naturalization certificate.

For housing/utilities:

- ◆ Copy of lease, copy of bill in your name, copy of eviction notice or letter from landlord stating you are late with rent payment and notifying you of eviction proceedings in the event of rent non-payment.
- ◆ Shut-off notice from utility company.

Proof of all income in household:

- ◆ 90 days of bank statements, EPPI Card printouts for last 90 days-Unemployment Benefit Card Statement, pay stubs, Public Assistance Benefit statements, i.e., TANF, Food Stamps, Medicaid, Social Security.
